CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK SADLE.

of Route 4, Albany, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of _____ for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14824 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
0.6 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
9.7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 14,

T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M.
as projected on D. L. C. 48.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a stake which is 25° west 39.65 chains from the south west corner of the east half of the Donation Land Claim of D. R. Hodges known on the plats of the United States Surveys as Notification No. 1723 and Claim No. 48 in township 10 South of range 4 west of the Willamette meridian, in Benton County, Oregon, and running from thence north 25° west 20.35 chains to the north boundary line of the aforesaid claim; thence north 65° east on the north boundary line of said claim to the northeast corner thereof, a distance of 53.33 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains, thence south 25° east 20.35 chains, thence south 65° west 53.33 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains, to the place of beginning, containing 108 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less in Benton County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
