## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That H. MCNAUGHTAN

State of Oregon of Route 1. Tangent , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya River a tributary of

for the purpose of Willamette River

irrigation under Permit No. 1119119 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 13, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.113 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET SWT, Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 4 West. W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre in SWA NEA, 5.7 acres in NET SWA, 3.2 acres in NWA SEA, Section 26, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W.M. as projected on D. L. C. 62

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

TRACT A: 15.87 acres off the west end of the following described premises: Beginning at the southeast corner of the G. H. Hughes D.L.C. No. 78 T. 11 S. R. 4 W. of the W.M., thence west 34 chains; thence south 10.50 chains to a stake; thence east 34 chains to astake in the east boundary line of the Vincent Watson D. L. C. No. 62 in said township and range; thence north 10.60 chains to the place of beginning, EXCEPT the right of the public to the use of that portion of said premises lying in roads.

TRACT B: Beginning at a stake 10.60 chains south of the southeast corner of the G. H. Hughes D.L.C. No. 78, T. 11 S. R. 4 W. of the W.M.; thence south 10.60 chains to a stake which is 29.10 chains north of the southeast corner of the Vincent Watson, D.L.C. No. 62 in said township and range; thence west parallel with the south boundary line of the said Watson D. L. C. 34 chains to a stake which stands 2 links south of an Ash tree 14 inches in diameter marked with three notches on the south side; thence north 10.60 chains to a stake; thence east 34 chains to the place of beginning, EXCEPT that portion of said premises conveyed by Hinerva J. Smith to Anna A. Jones by deed recorded July 28, 1916 in Book 109, page 175. Deed Records; ALSO EXCEPT the right of the public in and to the use of that portion of said premises in roads.

TRACT C: Beginning north 29.10 chains and west 17.40 chains from the southeast corner of the Vincent Watson D.L.C. No. 62, T. 11 S. R. 4 W. of the W.M.; thence west 25.47 chains to the center of the center of the Calapooia Creek; thence southeasterly along the center of the main channel of said creek up stream to a point due south of the place of beginning; thence north 2.50 chains to the place of beginning, EXCEPT the right of the public to the use of that portion of said premises lying in roads.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
