CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL A. GIERKE

of 334 E. E. 71st Avenue, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14981 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 8, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 19,
T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W. M.
as projected on William Arthur D.L.C. 38

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The following described property in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit: Part of Section 19, T. 2 S., R. 3 E. of the W.M., situate in the William Arthur D.L.C., described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe on the claim line which is 1247 feet south 78° 30' east from the southwest corner of William Arthur D.L.C. No. 38, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., of the W. M.; thence south 78° 30' east 180 feet to a pipe; thence north 27° east 307 feet to the center of Clear Creek; thence down stream approximately 500 feet to a point which is north 29° west 214 feet and north 12° 35' west 160 feet from the place of beginning; thence south 12° 35' east 160 feet; thence south 29° east 214 feet to the place of beginning, except easement for bridge and right to use present roadway to Redland Road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
