CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BUFORD KIGHT**

of Route 1, Box 524, North Bend, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Coos Bay for the purpose of domestic and irrigation under Permit No. 15044 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 4, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second— being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 13 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
0.6 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 24,
T. 24 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the west boundary of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, with the Southerly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway, a distance of 245.0 feet South of the Northwest Corner of the said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24;— and running thence along the said Southerly boundary of the State Highway as follows: S. 59° 27' E. for a distance of 268.16 feet; thence S. 49° 23' E. for a distance of 218.61 feet; thence S. 38° 42' E. for a distance of 113.12 feet; thence leaving the Southerly boundary of the State Highway and running S. 38° 09' E. along the Southerly boundary of a driveway for a distance of 155.05 feet to a point from which a blazed 20 inch spruce tree bears N. 50° W. a distance of 6.1 feet; thence S. 71° 41' W. for a distance of 593.58 feet, more or less, to a point on the West boundary of the said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24; thence North along the said West boundary of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24 for a distance of 675.35 feet to the point of beginning, containing 4.92 acres, more or less, and being a portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
