**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **WALTER J. GEARIN**

of Times Building, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15055 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 19, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.5 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
3.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 32,

T. 3 S., R. 2 W.; W.M.

as projected on Etienne Lucier D.L.C. 65

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appraiser as follows: beginning 13.46 chains N 45° E. 1.11 chains N 65° 9' W and 4.10 chains N 45° W from the N.E. corner of the George Aplin D.L.C. in T 3 S. R. 2 W. of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence N 44° 20' W along the center line of the county road 9.94 chains; thence N 45° E 25 chains to an iron rod on the bank of the Willamette river from which a 33 inch maple bears N52° W 16.3 links; thence down said river following the meanders of the same about 11.00 chains to a yew post from which an 18 inch balm bears N 23° W 24 links and a 36 inch balm bears S 26° E 50 links; thence S 45° W 20.93 chains to the point of beginning; containing 22.83 acres of land more or less in the Etienne Lucier D.L.C. in T 3 S.R. 2 W Marion County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
