that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 sac. 2t. for mining, A rate of flow of 0.90 sec.ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 0.45 sec, ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 108 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 2 acres in NELSEL: 1 acre in NWISEL: 3 acres in SWISEL and 21 acres in SELSEL of Section 33: 6.5 acres in SWISEL of Section 34. Tp. 13 S. R. 41 E. W. M., 15 acres in NELSEL of Section 4: 1 acre in NWINEL of Section 3. Tp. 14 S. R. 41 E. W. M., in Malheur County. Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
