CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HERMAN A. MCCULLOUGH

of Route 2. Box 450, Medford , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

spring a tributary of Bear Creek, tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, including irrigation of a garden not to exceed a acre in area under Perhit No. 17009 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 16, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 NE4, Section 20, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acrc,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1 NE 1 Section 20 T. 37 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 40 rods South of the section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21 in Township 37 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon; thence West 40 rods 7 1/4 links; thence South 28 rods, thence East 40 rods 7 1/4 links; thence North 28 rods to the point of beginning. EXCEPTING therefrom the following: Beginning at a point 51 rods 8½ feet South of the section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21 in Township 37 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Oregon; thence North 11 rods 8½ feet; thence West 15 rods 8½ feet to the southwesterly line of tract described in Volume 159 of page 537 the Dead Records of Jackson County, Oregon; thence in a Southeasterly direction to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
