CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. E. McMANUS

of Gold Hill, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an old mining tunnel a tributary of Footh Creek Watershed, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic and fire protection under Permit No. 17131 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 37 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Deed recorded in Jackson County Deed records Vol. 232 page 154 as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of section 2 in township 37 south of range 4 west of the Willamette Meridian, thence running north on the line between sections one and two, 1338.6 feet thence south 62 degrees west 871 feet; thence south 47 degrees east 475.8 feet; thence south 32 degrees and 22 minutes east 336.16 feet; thence south 43 degrees east 419.05 feet to the point of beginning, containing 11.54 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
