## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That ... DALE VINCENT

of Gold Hill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

a spring for the purpose of domestic, including irrigation of not to exceed ½ acre domestic lawns and gardens under Permit No. 17694 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

March 11, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW<sub>4</sub> SW<sub>4</sub>, Section 25, Township 36 South,

Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_ \_ \_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 25 T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

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Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: That part of Lots 18 and 19 of the Amended Plat of Lots 1, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 of Riverside subdivision in Section 25, Township 36 South, Range 4 West of the W. M., in Jackson County, Oregon, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe at the point where the line between Lots 17 and 18 of said plat, intersects the westerly right of way line of the Pacific Highway; thence southwesterly along the west right of way line of said highway to an iron stake a distance of 537.5 feet; thence N. 66° 45' West 82 feet to an iron stake; thence N. 66° 45' W., about 50 feet to Rogue River; thence northwesterly along Rogue River to a point which bears N. 86° 18' W. from the point of beginning, thence South 86° 18' East to the point of beginning.

- The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
