CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL W. NYGREN

of Lake Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three unnamed springs a tributary of unnamed draws, tributary of Lake Creek, tributary of Little Butte Creek for the purpose of irrigation and domestic under Permit No. 17814 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 13, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second, being 0.065 c.f.s. from West Spring, 0.06 c.f.s. from Middle Spring and 0.05 c.f.s. from East Spring for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from West Spring for domestic,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 37 South, Range 1 East, W. M. and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 37 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres and domestic in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 12,
T. 37 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

4.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 7,
T. 37 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
