CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That TURNER MEMORIAL HOME

of Turner, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Santiam River a tributary of Santiam River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. E-82 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 28,
3.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 29,
T. 8 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

(Vol. 294 Page 590) Beginning on the Section line between Sections 28 and 29 in Township 8 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon at a point which is South 6.00 chains from the quarter corner between said Sections 28 and 29; thence West 7.33 chains; thence South 9° 19' East 5.505 chains; thence South 34° 50' West to the center meander line of Mill Creek; thence in an Easterly direction along said center meander line to the most Easterly Southeast corner of the 6.05 acres conveyed to Newland P. Webb and Clara N. Webb, husband and wife, recorded November 14, 1936 in Volume 227, Page 285 Deed Records; thence North along the East line of said tract to the Southwest corner of the 45.5 link strip of land conveyed to Newland P. Webb and wife, recorded December 29, 1938 in Volume 235, Page 267, Deed Records; thence East along said South line 45.5 links to the Southeast corner thereof on the Section line between Sections 28 and 29, Township 8 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; thence North along said line to the place of beginning.

(Vol. 226, Page 229) Beginning at an iron pipe firmly set in the ground on the north boundary of C Street in Turner, Oregon, 72.9 feet north 81° 05' east of a point 70 feet north 9° 30' west of the northwest corner of block 1 in East Addition; and from thence running north 81° 05' east along the north boundary of C Street and property belonging to the school district to the center of Mill Creek; thence meandering northerly and westerly along the center line of said Mill Creek to a point north of the place of beginning; thence south 321 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
