for the purpose of the irrigation of 165 acres of land, domestic and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lalheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Record of the Record of the Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1882 for 125 acres and 1908 for 40 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 4.14 sec. ft. from reb. 15th to May 1st and 2.07 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 495 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres in SW1W2; 20 acres in SE1W2; 40 acres in SE2SW2 and 15 acres in SW2SE1; of Section 4, Tp. 17 S. R. 44 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
