**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** A. A. SOULE<sup>1</sup>, M. D.

of P. O. Box 1158, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of supplemental irrigation, domestic, heating and medicinal under Permit No. U-137 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 24, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation, 0.02 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.066 c.f.s. for heating and 0.044 c.f.s. for medicinal.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 9 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from March 1st to September 30th of each year and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated subsequent to May 1st of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre, domestic, heating  
and medicinal in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 28,  
T. 38 S., R. 9 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Main Street which is South Eighty Nine (89) degrees, Eighteen (18) Minutes East. a distance of Nine Hundred Twelve and Two tenths (912.2) feet, along the northerly line of Main Street from the Southeast corner of Block Fifty Seven (57), Second Hot Springs Addition to the city of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon; thence North No (0) degrees, Forty Two (42) Minutes East a distance of Two Hundred Thirty Four and Five Tenths (234.5) feet more or less to a point which is Twenty (20) feet distance southwesterly at right angles from the southwesterly line of the United States Reclamation Service canal right of way; thence South Seventy Five (75) degrees, Twenty Two and One-half (22 1/2) minutes East. Parallel with the Southwest line of said canal right of way and Twenty (20) feet distant southwesterly at right angles therefrom a distance therefrom a distance of Fifty Five (55) feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of that parcel of land deeded to Dr. A. A. Soule<sup>1</sup> April 24, 1923, thence in a southerly direction and parallel to Mortimer Avenue a distance of Two Hundred Fourteen and Eight Tenths (214.8) feet, more or less, to the northerly line of Main Street, thence westerly along the Northerly line of Main St. a distance of Fifty (50) feet to place of beginning, all in Williams Addition to the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon, according to the duly recorded plat thereof filed in the office of the County Clerk of said County, containing approximately Three Tenths (.3) of an acre.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
