CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. T. MCDONALD

of Lakeview , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well a tributary of for the purpose of irrigation and domestic for one family under Permit No. U-117 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 25, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.085 cubic foot per second, being 0.075 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3/4 of one acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any period of 30 days prior to June 1st, \$\frac{1}{2}\$ of one acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any period of 30 days after June 1st and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 2\frac{1}{2}\$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any irrigation season,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 3 acres in the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section h, T. 39 S., R. 20 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
