CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That UTAH CANNING CO.

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well a tributary of for the purpose of canning operations under Permit No. U-158 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.22 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 1, Township 5 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropiator as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of Walla Walla Street, in the City of Freewater, Umatilla County, Oregon 250 feet North of the North line of Main Street; running thence Northerly along the West line of said Walla Walla Street 290 feet, more or less to the Southerly line of the right of way of the Oregon Washington Railroad and Navigation Company; thence Southwesterly along said Southerly right of way line to its intersection with the North line of Main Street in said City of Freewater, if said North line were extended Westerly; thence Easterly along said Westerly extended North line of Main Street and along the North line of said Main Street to a point which is 200 feet Westerly from the intersection of said North line of Main Street with the West line of Walla Walla Street; thence Northerly at right angles to Main Street 150 feet; thence at right angles Easterly 100 feet; thence at right angles Northerly 100 feet; thence at right angles Easterly 100 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
