**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** J. T. WHARTON

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well a tributary of for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. U-164 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 29, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33  
T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of the O. W. R. & N. Co.'s right of way 304 feet East and 1310.3 feet south of the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) running thence North 881.3 feet; thence East 660 feet; thence South 508.3 feet to the line of the O. W. R. & N. Co.'s right of way; thence Southwesterly along said right of way 763 feet to the point of beginning. Excepting an 8 foot right of way for a ditch as conveyed to Pleasant View irrigation Company, A Corporation, by Right of Way Deed recorded in Book 90, Page 197 of the Deed Records of Umatilla County, Oregon.

All being East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Umatilla and State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
