## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THE INCORPORATED CITY OF MILTON, OREGON

of Milton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork of Walla Walla River for the purpose of

development of electrical power and municipal use under Permit No. 7830 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 2, 1926

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 86.3 cubic feet per second, being 80.5 c.f.s. for power and 5.3 c.f.s. for municipal use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

Range 36 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Section 11,

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights for the development of POWER as specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
