of Newberg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Chehalem Creek

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 11577 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1935

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed O.40 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEA SWA, Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

ll.8 acres in the SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, as projected on D.L.C. 40, Section 19, Township 3 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

16.7 acres in the NE4 NW4, Section 30, Township 3 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe set at the Northeast corner of the LEVI HACEY Donation Land Claim, Notification No. 1434, Claim No. 41, in Township 3 South, of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian. Oregon: thence North 26 East along the West line of tract set apart to AMEROSE 5. Mellinger in decree of Court, March, 1912, 317.4 feet to stake set at the Northwest corner of C. S. 918, from which a maple 8" in diameter bears South 1° West 64 links and a maple 6" in diameter bears North 89°East 45 links; thence North 89°57 East along North line of C. S. No. 918, 419.6 feet to iron pipe set for the Southwest corner of the J. B. ROGERS Donation Land Claim, marked an alder 10" in diameter bears North 81°45 East 22.7 feet, alder 10" South 19° West 4 feet, alder 10" North 39° West 8.7 feet, a cedar 8" North 8°30' West 46.5 feet; thence North 0° 40' West on true line between the ROGERS and RAMSEY Donation Land Claim 1997.4 feet to

the South side of Chehalem Creek; at this point there was an allowance of 30 feet from the South bank to the center of the creek; which center is the true line of property; thence North 60° 58' West following an offset of 30 feet along the South bank of creek 373 feet; thence North 21° 10! West 111.2 feet; thence North 12° 19' West 138.5 feet to stake on South end of the MTLL lot; therce South 86° 37' West along South side of said MTLL lot 127.8 feet to iron pin at Southwest corner of MTLL lot; thence North 25° 11' West 232.7 feet to bolt driven in the center of the road as follows: it also being the correct angles and distances as turned from the West line of C. S. No. 1335, from the Northwest corner thereof; South 33° 11.1' West 261 feet; thence South 11° 11' West 108.5 feet to Northwest corner of C. S. No. 133! Lot One, set on the East line of Lot Two from which a fir 10" in diameter bears South 7° West 26.5 feet; thence South 0° 16' West by calculation for angle and 2123.6 feet by former measurement to the Southwest corner of Lot One, C. S. No. 1335, from which the ash marked in sal survey being 30" in diameter bears South 86° 30' East 75 links; thence North 88° 56' East on South line of Lot One, 651.8 feet to beginning, and containing 60.33 acres plus 10 of an acre in the creek, making a total of 60.73 acres, and the said premises above described bein the same as embraced in and known as Lots One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven and Eight of SOUTH NEWBERG SUBURBAN ACRE TRACTS, in Yamhill County, State of Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
