CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Haines , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hot Spring commonly known as "Fisher's Spring" a tributary of for the purpose of irrigation, domestic for one family and stock under Permit No. 11796 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1935

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.02 c.f.s. for domestic and stock,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NEL NWL, Section 10, Township 7 South, Range 38 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
