CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify.** That **LELAND HEART**

of **Crosswell**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Coast Fork Willamette River** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of **irrigation** under Permit No. **11963** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **November 14, 1935**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 13, Township 19 South, Range **3 West, W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$**  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**3.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on D.L.C. 48**  
**16.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on D.L.C. 48**  
**Section 13,**  
**Township 19 South, Range 3 West, W. M.**

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriate as follows:

The South Twenty (20) acres of the following described premises: Commencing at a point North 89° 24' West 26.58 chains from the Northeast corner of the Joseph N. Petty D.L.C. No. 48 in Township Nineteen (19) South Range Three (3) West of the Willamette Meridian, in Lane County, Oregon, and running thence South 3/4° West 13.54 chains, thence North 89° West 5.50 chains, thence South 1/4° West 16.33 chains, thence East 22.19 chains, thence North 1° 15' East 4.71 chains, thence North 15° 45' East 4.82 chains, thence North 22° East to a point South 89° 24' East from the South boundary line of a tract conveyed to Van E. Grousbeck by William J. Hammond and wife, which now appears of record in page 86 Vol. 86 of Lane County, Oregon deed records, thence North 89° 24' West to the Southwest corner of said tract conveyed by Van E. Grousbeck as aforesaid, thence North 11.94 chains, to a point 14.41 chains North 89° 24' West from the Northeast corner of the aforesaid Joseph N. Petty D.L.C. No. 48, and which is also the northwest corner of said tract conveyed as aforesaid unto Van E. Grousbeck, thence North 89° 24' West 12.17 chains more or less to the place of beginning, containing 56.57 acres, more or less, excepting therefrom a 30 foot strip conveyed to Lane County, Oregon, as will appear by reference to page 352 Volume 70 Lane County, Oregon Deed Records, all in Lane County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
