CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BOB. B. WEBB

of Route 1, Yamhill., State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Yamhill River

a tributary of Yamhill River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 13290 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 11, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW SW SW Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.9 acres in the NW4 SW4, 8.0 acres in the SW4 SW4, as projected on Wm. D. Stillwell D.L.C. 41 Section 5, T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A part of the Wm. D. Stilwell Donation Land Claim #hl, Notification #1579, in Twp. 3 South, Range h West of the Willamette Meridian, in Yamhill County, Oregon, also being a part of the Ben F. Laughlin farm as deeded by him to the United States and now designated as Farm Unit 22 of United States Farm Security Administration Yamhill Farms Project, and more particularly described as follows, towit: Beginning at a 2" iron pipe at the intersection of the center line of a County road with the North or East right of way line of the Carlton & Coast Railroad, from which the Northwest corner of the Samuel McSween Donation Land Claim, which is also an angle point in the Wm. D. Stilwell Donation Land Claim, bears South 18° 29' 20" East 741.65 feet, and running Thence along the North right of way line of the Carlton & Coast Railroad 1034.30 feet to an iron pipe; Thence North 2° 29' 10" East 995.47 feet to a stone in the center line of the road; Thence North 61° 32" East 699.60 feet to an iron pipe; Thence due East 1076.36 feet to the center line of the Yamhill River; Thence South 38° 26' 27" East 155.59 feet; Thence South 19° 22' 40" West 153.71 feet; Thence South 67° 37' 11" West 91.92 feet; Thence North 62° 06' 10" West 96.18 feet; Thence South 41° 09' 25" West 1451.91 feet to an iron pipe in the center line of the road; Thence South 18° 29' 20" East 180.00 feet to the point of beginning; This unit contains 49.720 acres, more or less.
