CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. E. CAMPBELL

of Route 2, Box 259, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13613 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 25, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D. L. C. 67
4.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D. L. C. 67
Section 21,
T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Part of the D.L.C. claim of Henry Nolan, Sr. and wife being claim No 67 T.1.S. R. 2 W of Willamette Meridian the beginning point of land to be described is reached as follows; Commencing at the corner of Section 15, 16, 21, and 22 T.1.S.R.2 W Willamette Meridian, thence south on section line 8.00 chains, more or less, to the division line of said claim; thence west on said division line 10.40 chains to the beginning point of the land to be described, thence north 9 23' west along center of said road far enough that a due west line to the center of Tualatin River will cut off 12 1/2 acres, thence west to the center of Tualatin River, thence down the same with the meanderings thereof to said division line, thence east along said division line 14.32 chains to the place of beginning, containing 12 1/2 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
