and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, Malheur TATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 13 at in the Order Record of the R 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1895

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose Saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 sec. ft. for mining and a rate of flow of

0.05 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 0.03 sec. \_t. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 6 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows 2 acres in SW2SW2 of Section 29, Tp. 13 S. R. 41 . W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.
