CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KHOTE DIGERNESS

of Route 2, Box 89, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14829 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 7, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET SW2, Section 22, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each a re irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.2 acres in NE SW

Section 22 T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning 50.93 chains South of the quarter section corner on the North line of Section 22 in T. 6 S. R. 1 W. of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon; thence South 9.30 chains to a steel bar in the Southeast corner of the Nimrod Jenkins D.L.C.: thence West 11.14 chains to the center of the Abiqua Creek; thence down said creek N. 27° 30° West 2.15 chains; thence North 22° West 3.10 chains; thence North 66° West 60 links to the center of the Highway Bridge crossing said Creek; thence North 44° 40° East along said Highway 2.00 chains; thence North 7° 35° West, still in the said Highway 1.25 chains to a stone; thence North 82° 52° East 12.70 chains to an iron bar in the point of beginning, containing 10.58 acres of land, more or less, in Section 22, T. 6 S. R. 1 W. of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
