## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That v. c. BROWNSON

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River domestic for one family, including the irrigation of a garden not exceeding of the state Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby a firmed dates from June 2, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SE4, Section 27, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: NWA SEA, as projected on Joseph Cornelisons D.L.C. 46
Section 27,

T. 29 S., R., 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the J. M. Mackintosh land in Sec. 27 Township 29 South, Range 5 West of W.M.; thence South along the Mackintosh line to center of South Myrtle Creek; thence meandering center of said Myrtle Creek in a westerly direction to J. T. Wood's east line; thence North to the South line of Lazarus Wright Donation Land Claim; thence east along the South line of the Lazarus Wright Claim to the place of beginning.

The tract being a part of subdivision 4 and 5 of the Joseph Corte and Donation Land Claim and containing eight acres, more or less, all situated in Luglas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
