CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST ANNAS

of Route 4, Box 81 F, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed spring a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of stock

under Permit No. 15507 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 3, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the south boundary line of the William Armstrong and Jane Armstrong, his wife, D. L. C. Notification No. 2524, Certificate No. 4351 in Township two, South, of Range one East of the Willamette Meridian 10.68 chains East of the southwest corner of said claim and running thence North 28.48 chains to division line of said claim; thence East on said division line 10.68 chains; thence South 28.48 chains to the South boundary of said claim; thence West to the place of beginning, containing 30 acres, more or less, excepting therefrom that tract of 22 feet by 10 rods conveyed to John Boylen, in Book 52 of Deeds, at page 27 and those several tracts conveyed to O. G. Downing and Oscar G. Downing, recorded in Book 54 of Deeds, at page 448 and Book 63 of Deeds, at page 320.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
