CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOELSON LUMBER COMPANY

of Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Deer Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of filling mill pond under Permit No. 15681 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 27 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 38,
Section 19,
T. 27 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 8 of First Brookside Addition to the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon, according to the official plat and survey thereof now on file in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, running thence westerly along the North side of East Avenue or the Dixonville Road and the Southerly line of First Brookside Addition 747 feet thence North 375 feet thence East 747 feet thence South 375 feet to the place of beginning, being a part of Lots 4, 5, 6, and 7 of said First Brookside Addition to the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon, and containing 6.43 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
