CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEO. J. McCLANE

of Canyonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 15683 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 28, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET SWT, as projected on James G. Clark D.L.C. 51, Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated at ig the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the NE4 SW4, as projected on James G. Clark, D.L.C. 51 Section 27,
Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point 11. chains 5h links west of the South East corner of the James G. Clark D. L. C. No. 51 in section twenty seven township thirty south of Range Five west of the W. M. thence north h chains thence west 5 chains and 30 links more or less to the county road thence South with the County Road 4 chas. Thence East Five chains to the place of beginning containing two acres of land more or less., on Douglas County State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the la ds or place of use herein described.
