CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED S. BYNON, GEORGE E. BYNON & JESSIE HARRITT

of 1025 Garnet Street, Salem, _____, State of Oregon _____, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Brush College Community Club Spring a tributary of Willamette River _____ for the purpose of domestic for three families under Permit No. 15936 _____ of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 17, 1944.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on C. O. Hosford D.L.C. 65, Section 8, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on C. O. Hosford D.L.C. 65
Section 8,
Township 7 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe 8.00 chains West of the Southwest corner of the E. F. Hosford D.L.C. in Township 7 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon; thence South 85° 30' East 2.24 chains to an iron pipe; thence South 74° East 5.10 chains to an iron pipe; thence South 10° West 6.06 chains to an iron pipe; thence South 22° 30' West 8.60 chains to an iron pipe; thence West 8.80 chains to an iron pipe; thence North 22° 15' East 7.86 chains to an iron pipe; thence North 35° 30' East 3.86 chains to an iron pipe; thence N. 19° E. 226 ch. thence North 4° 00' East 2.80 chains to the place of beginning containing 10.00 acres, more or less, in Polk County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
