CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **MRS. R. C. NOLAND**

of Box 448, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the purpose of domestic for one family under Permit No. 15941 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 22, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43, Section 13, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. 43
Section 13,
Township 26 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point from which the corner common to sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, Township 26 South of Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian bears South 37° 14' West 2063.1 feet; thence North 63° 30' West 135 feet; thence North 16° 01' East to the North Umpqua River; thence following said river upstream approximately 155 feet to the West boundary of the George Kohlhausen property as fenced and occupied; thence South 18° 39' West approximately 420.2 feet to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom the County Road.

(The above described real property is the identical land conveyed to Charles S. Johnston by D. H. Morgan, et ux., and G. R. Bates, et ux., by deed dated August 21, 1937, recorded on January 18, 1938, on page 218 of Volume 99 of the Deed Records of Douglas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
