CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. F. CONNELLY and MILDRED CONNELLY

of Route 1, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed springs a tributary of a fork of West Dairy Creek for the purpose of domestic and irrigation under Permit No 16090 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre and domestic in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4,
T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: That portion of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Twp. 1 North Range 4 W. of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the SE corner of said subdivision, thence W. along the S line thereof S 88° 58' W. 1532.7' to an iron, thence N. 32° 41' E. 397.6' to a point in the center of County Road No. 63, thence along the center of said road N. 41° 28' W. 884.2' to an angle in said road, thence N. 31° 1' W. 457.8' to point in said road, thence E 2157.6' to NE corner of said subdivision thence along the E. line thereof S. 0° 46' W. 1362.9' to the place of beginning, containing 53.45 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
