for the purpose of the irrigation of 183 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Mounty of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1887 for the irrigation of 18 acres and 1897 for the irrigation of 105.5 acres from North Fork of Willow Creek; 1880 for the irrigation of 15 acres; 1881 for the irrigation of 25 acres; 1882 for the irrigation of 19.5 acres from South Fork of Willow Creek;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 4.58 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 2.32 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 549 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
