CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MONROE LUMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 868, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Amazon Creek to be used in reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-810 a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of log pond under Permit No. 16186 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point which is the Sec. cor. common to Sec's 29, 30, 31, 32 thence, East along the north line of Sec. 32 a distance of 30', thence North along the Co. road R. W. line a distance of 277.9' to the center line of the S.P. main line R.R., thence N $81^{\circ}17'$ E. along the center line of said R. R. 1311.9', thence S. $00^{\circ}38'$ E. 519.5' thence; S $83^{\circ}42'$ W. 1326.5' to the west line of Sec. 32 thence; North along the west line of Sec. 32 a distance of 75' to the place of beginning. The area lying with in Sec. 29 and 32 Tp. S. R. 4 W. W. M., Lane County, Oregon and containing there in all dikes and water storage area included in the Silver Falls Timber Co's log pond at Danabo.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
