of Eugene , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpque River log pond

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16187 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 14, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW SW SW Section 3, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as, all of Lots 3 and 4, Sec. 11, (NW4NW4 & NE4NW4 & NW4NE4) T. 28 S.; R. 6 W.; W.M. which lie between the old Pacific Highway and the west right-of way line of the S.P. Railroad and North of the east and west county road No. 110 which runs into Green Sta., including Blocks 1, 2, and 3, Town of Green Station, and excepting from the above that portion of 100, Green Valley Orchard Tracts, which lies South of the north line of said sec. 11.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
