of Dryden , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of U. S. Spring and unnamed creek

under Permit No. 16214 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 12, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Spring for domestic, and 0.14 c.f.s. from creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1 NW1, Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 6 West, W. M. from Spring, and NE1 NE1, Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 7 West, W. M. from creek.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or it equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic in NE SE from spring 7.0 acres in NE SE from creek Section 13, T. 38 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
