**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That ELLEN M. HOLDER**

of **Vida**, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of McKenzie River for the purpose of domestic for one family, stock and chickens under Permit No. 16217 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 23, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropiator as follows:

The Southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 27 in township 16 South Range 2 East of Willamette Meridian, except that certain tract conveyed to Audie Donahoe and Ida Donahoe by deed recorded Dec. 31, 1923 on page 84 of Vol. 139 Lane County Deed Records; containing 38 acres more or less; also Beginning at a stone set in the ground being 1210.64 feet south and 399.96 feet East of the quarter section corner between sections 27 and 34 township 16 south Range 2 East of Willamette Meridian, and running thence south 77° 00' East 290.0 feet; thence south 61° 25' east 52.6 feet; thence south 36° 33' West 754.0 feet to the right bank of the McKenzie River; thence north 49° 22' West 318.8 feet; thence north 36° 33' east 608.1 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres more or less in Lane County, Oregon; Also Beginning at a point which is 12.61 chains south of the quarter section corner between Sec. 27 and 34 in Twp. 16 South of Range 2 East of the Will. Mer. in Lane County, Ore., and running thence south 12.60 chains to the north bank of the McKenzie River; thence down said bank N 52° 30' west 4.00 chains; thence North 17° 18' east 10.65 chains to the place of beginning and containing 2 acres more or less. Also Beginning at a point which is 13.25 chains south of the quarter section corner between secs. 27 and 34 in Twp. 16 South of Range 2 East of Will. Mer. in Lane Co., Ore., and running thence south 47° 5' east 7.01 chains, thence south 70° east 0.99 chains; thence south 36° 33'

west 9.06 chains to the north bank of the McKenzie River thence north 35° west 0.87 chains; thence north 11.80 chains to the place of beginning and containing 3.78 acres more or less, all in Lane County, Oregon. Except therefrom the right of way of the McKenzie Highway. Also that certain water right granted to Walter E. Post and Jessie W. Post by the State of Oregon by instrument recorded June 14, 1928 on page 58 of Volume 1, Lane County Certificate of Water Rights Records. Also all the right, title and interest of the grantors in and to the gateway or right of way now existing over the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 34, township 16 South, Range 2 E. W. M. extending from the McKenzie Highway to the southeast corner of the tract first above described.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
