and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, "alheur of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at in the Order Record of the R 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1883:

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.73 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 1.87 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 44? acre feet.
