CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WAVA HAGA CHESLEY

of Bandon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of domestic for one family under Permit No. 16927 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 20, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 28,
T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 308.6 feet South of the North West corner of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of section 28, in Township 28 South of Range No. 14 West of the Willamette Meridian, Coos County Oregon. Thence East 300.0 feet; thence South 375.8 feet; thence West 300.0 feet; thence North 375.8 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.588 acres, excepting a strip 10.0 feet wide off the entire West side for right of way.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
