ofRoute 1, Box 481, Ashland , State of Oregon , nas made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of Bear Creek

domestic for two families and irrigation

under Permit No. 16956

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 24, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.017 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.001 c.f.s. for domestic from west spring, 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.002 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWA SWA. Section 13. Township 39 South, Range l East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.0 acre and domestic in NE SWA. 0.5 acre and domestic in NW SW 3, Section 13, T. 39 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

From the northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 54 in Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, measure east 13 chains and south 8.04 chains to a point on the easterly side line of a county road known as the Crowson Road for the place of beginning of the tract to be described;

From this point run South 59? 15' East 396 feet;

Thence North 49° 45! East 732 feet;

Thence North 3° 35' East 233 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the south line of the right of way of road known as Crowson Road;

Thence west end southwesterly along said right of way of said Road a distance of 1090 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing $7 \, 1/7$ acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
