**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** CHARLES TAYLOR, JACOB H. OWENS and LOMA W. OWENS

of Route 4, Box 231, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cold Springs Creek and unnamed spring a tributary of Savage Creek, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation, domestic for one family and stock under Permit No. 17122 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 1, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 c.f.s. for irrigation and stock from creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
domestic and stock in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 31,  
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Volume 251, Page 345, of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon describes the following land belonging to Charles Taylor and wife; Beginning at the SW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of S. 31, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M., thence running 160 rods east; thence 60 rods north; thence 160 rods west; thence south 60 rods to point of beginning, containing 60 acres more or less, all in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
