CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HALBERT W. BOOTH

of Azalea, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Russell Creek a tributary of Cow Creek for the purpose of domestic for one family and irrigation under Permit No. 18302 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 16, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.015 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 32 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 1.0 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 5,
T. 32 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point marked by a 1" iron pipe which is ten feet east of the quarter corner between Sections 5 & 6, T. 32 S., R. 4 W., W.M. Douglas County, Oregon. Thence North 271.7 ft. thence N. 69° 45' E. 215.0 ft. thence south 346.0 ft. thence W. 200 ft. to place of beginning containing 1.4 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
