**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HENRY B. PEYRON

of Baker, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 8717 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1928;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
25 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 36  
T. 8 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

Note: This certificate is issued pursuant to the provisions of decree of the Circuit Court for Baker County dated August 3, 1945, in the matter of James E. Prowell, et al., v. Henry B. Peyron, et al., so as to correctly describe the place of use of the 65 acres being irrigated, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Henry B. Peyron and recorded at Page 9229, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
