of Jordan Valley , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Owyhee River a tributary of Snake River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 15323 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 29, 1942

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.493 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 6, Township 32 South, Range 42 East,

W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtisth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall not exceed one acre foot per acre during any calendar wonth prior to June 1st, and three-fourths acre foot per acre during any calendar month after June 1st, of each year; and the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 15th, shall not exceed three acre feet per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
