Oregon of Kohlhagen Apts., Roseburg State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Days Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of

irrigation

Permit A-1-500-1-49

under Permit No. 111199 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1934

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_{3}^{1}$   $SW_{4}^{1}$ , Section 1, and  $SW_{4}^{2}$   $SE_{4}^{2}$ , Section 2, Township 30 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.1 acres in SWA SWA, as projected on Joseph P. Wilson, D.L.C. No. 50 Section 1,

1.7 acres in SW4 SE4, as projected on Joseph P. Wilson, D.L.C. No. 50 7.3 acres in SE4 SE4, as projected on Joseph P. Wilson, D.L.C. No. 50 Section 2,

T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
