**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify; That J. E. SMITH**

of 1855 Saginaw Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River and Horseshoe Lake a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 13861 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 22, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.35 cubic feet per second, being 2.675 c.f.s. from each source

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located ~~in the~~ along river within Sections 15 and 22 and along lake within Section 23, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W. M. on property described herein,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The West half of the Donation Land Claim of Laurent Sauvien & Francis Sauvien, his wife, the same being Claim No. 67, in sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, township four South, Range three West and Claim No. 62, in Section 19, Township 4 south, Range two west of the Willamette Meridian Marion County Oregon and said West half being the same set apart by patent to the said Francis Sauvien, and containing 317 acres of land more or less.

Lots numbered five & six, in section fifteen (15); Lots numbered three, four, five and six in section twenty-three (23); Lots five, six, seven, and eight, in section twenty-two (22); and the North-east quarter (NE 1/4) of section twenty two; all in township four (4) south, range three (3) west of Willamette Meridian containing five hundred (500) acres more or less.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
