CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN A. and MARION BOSCOVICH

of 1903 E. Walker Road, Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of _____ for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 14781 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 4, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.007 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 10
T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M.
0.3 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 11
T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M.
all being in Lot 59, Steel's Addition

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A part of Lot 59 Steels Addition to Beaverton as shown on the duly recorded map & plat thereof, more particularly described as beginning at an iron pipe at the northwest corner of said lot; thence south 0° 02' east on the west line of said lot, 616 feet; thence east parallel with the north line of said lot, 159 ft. to the true place of beginning of the tract to be described; thence continuing east parallel with the north line of said lot 336 ft to the east line of said lot; thence north 0° 02' west on said east line, 308 ft; thence west parallel with the north line of said lot 141 feet thence north parallel with the east line of said lot 308 feet to the north line of said lot thence west on said north line 195 feet to a point 159 feet east of the northwest corner of said lot thence south 0° 02' east parallel with the west line of said lot 616 ft to the true place of beginning except that portion thereof within the boundaries of Walker Road.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
