CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JUNE E. THOMAS

of J. S. W. Salmon, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14925 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Jacob S. Risley, D. L. C. 51
Section 11

T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe driven at a point in the Southeasterly boundary of the duly recorded town plat of "Starkweather Acreage" as the same is duly recorded in the record of town plats of Clackamas County, Oregon, which point is S. 38° 48' E. 20.00 feet distant from the most Easterly corner of tract No. 2 of said town plat: Running thence tracing the Southeasterly boundary of said town plat and projection S. 51° 12' W. 495.39 feet to a point on the meander line of the right bank of the Willamette River at low water stage: thence following the meanders of the right bank of the Willamette River at low water stage, up stream S. 63° 58' E. 138.11 feet to a point from which an iron pipe bears N. 51° 12' E. 14.24 feet distant thence N. 51° 12' E. parallel to the Southeasterly boundary of "Starkweather acreage" plat 433.89 feet to an iron pipe: thence N. 38° 48' W. 125.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.333 acres, more or less. Being a part of the D.L.C. of Jacob S. Risley in T. 2, S. R. 1, E. of the W.M., Clackamas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
