CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** THE AMALGAMATED SUGAR COMPANY

of Ogden, State of Utah, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the purpose of manufacturing (processing sugar beets) under Permit No. 11,990 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 30, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 15.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 33, Township 19 South, Range 47 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point 38.0 feet South and 119.7 feet West of the N. W. corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32 T19S, R47E, W. M. and running thence S. 89° 50' E 1553.7 feet, thence South 131.0 feet, thence East 264.1 feet to the West Bank of the Snake River; Thence along said Bank of the Snake River S. 9° 04' E 202.5 feet, thence S. 14° 37' E 413.4 feet, thence S. 10° 52' E 203.7 feet, thence S. 6° 07' E 201.1 feet, thence S. 13° 13' E 566.0 feet, thence S. 3° 50' E 200.4 feet, thence S. 2° 11' W 200.1 feet, thence S. 3° 59' E 401.1 feet, thence S 5° 52' W 522.7 feet, thence S 18° 10' W 210.5 feet, thence S 32° 44' W 237.8 feet, thence S 38° 46' W 256.5 feet, thence S 64° 36' W 361.4 feet, thence S 78° 10' W 747.3 feet, thence S 71° 34' W 189.73 feet, thence S 58° 37' W 234.27 feet, thence S 54° 08' W 271.5 feet, thence S 54° 03' W 247.0 feet, thence 90° 52' W 200.0 feet, thence S 91° 50' W 125.0 feet, thence West 50.34 feet to the East Boundary of the Oregon Short Line Railroad Right-of-way; thence along said Railroad Right-of-way N. 6° 01' E 4415.9 feet to the point of beginning and comprising 407.27 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
