CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SAM AIDERSON

of Surmy Valley , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dredge seepage a tributary of Grave Creek for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 15616 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.313 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW1 SW1, Section 4, SW1 SE1 and SE1 SE1, Section 5, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{12}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres in SW4 SE4
12.0 acres in SE4 SE2

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A tract of land lying upon and along the line of Grave Creek in Sections 5, 8, 4, and 9, respectively, in Township 34 South, Range 6 West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County Oregon, more particularly described as follows, towit: All land in the S_2^1 of S_2^1 of Section 5, Township 34 South Range 6 West of Willamette Meridian, lying easterly of the center of Brimstone Creek, being a strip 660 feet wide and 4200 feet long more or less bounded on the South by the East and West line between Sections 5 and 8 of said Township and Range and bounded on the North by an East and West line which is parallel to the above mentioned line between said Sections 5 and 8 and 660 feet, more or less, North therefrom; less and excepting therefrom 4.55 acres sold to L.
