## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Rt. 3, Silverton ,State of Oregon ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Drift Creek a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 16123 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SW2, Section 9, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M., as projected on Joseph M. Blackerby D.L.C.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.8 acres in SE2 SE2, as projected on Joseph M. Blackerby D.L.C., Section 8,

6.2 acres in SW4 SW4, as projected on Joseph M. Blackerby D.L.C., Section 9,

Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Commencing 10.60 chains East of the Southwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of Joseyn M. Blackerby in Township 7, South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, State of Oregon, east 20.81 chains, north 23.55 chains west 6.91 chains, north 95/100 chains, west 13.90 chains, south 24.50 chains to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
